THIS WEEK'S DISCUSSION GUIDE UTILIZES THE QUESTIONS ANSWERED BY THE STAFF DURING THE SERMONS. USE THESE QUESTIONS TO GENERATE DISCUSSION WITHIN YOUR SMALL GROUP

- How do I balance my time between my marriage, my kids, my job and my home? (Matthew 6:21, Ecclesiastes 3:1-8)

- How can I stay consistent with my discipline? (Proverbs 22:6)
- What is the best discipline for young teens? (Ephesians 6:4, Proverbs 19:18)
- How do I instill what is right as a follower of Jesus versus the culture we live in? (John 17:15-18, Deuteronomy 11:18, 1 Corinthians 10:31, Proverbs 3:5-6)
- How do I manage technology? (1 Corinthians 10:23)
- How do we blend two families into one?
