DISCUSSION GUIDE

AUGUST 8, 2021

- 1. When we read passages such as; Psalm 139:13-16 and Exodus 4:10-12 what should we learn and embrace about ourselves and how GOD can use us?
- 2. Is success the true measure of finding our true purpose and meaning in life? Can success be a deception that actually keeps us from fulfilling our GOD given purpose?
- 3. What are some of the promises our Heavenly Father has given to us His children that we can cling to in our times of need and despair? For example; Hebrews 13:5; Philippians 4:19; 2 Corinthians 12:9; Psalm 37:25, etc.
- 4. As Christians shouldn't we view opposition and struggle as evidence of the spiritual battle the enemy is waging against our desire to grow in Christ? James 1:2-4; 1 Peter 4:12.
- 5. Everyone in Jesus' day and in our own time wants to see miracles, is it possible that GOD works miracles more often than we know but we simply are not looking with the right vision to notice them? Have miracles happened in our lives and we were excited at first and then talked ourselves out of believing in the miraculous?
- 6. GOD is omniscient, He knows the beginning from the end. GOD is immutable, that is, He does not change. Everything GOD does will always be consistent with His holy, righteous, just and loving character. We may not be able to see or understand how this is so, but can we look at a passage such as hardening the heart of Pharaoh and rest assured that GOD, Who knows the heart and mind of Pharaoh was just and righteous in His actions.
- 7. Is there true freedom in trusting GOD in His sovereignty our all the particulars in our lives? John 8:36; Psalm 37:4-5; 1 Peter 5:7.
