THE ROAD PLAN FOR @THEROADKIDS

1. Find the scripture in your bible and highlight it. (Make sure to get your parent's permission before highlighting).
2. Read the scripture.
3. You can use a notebook to record the ROAD journal prompts shown below, or if not ready for that, simply discuss it with your parent(s).

READ - Write the scripture reference you read today. (example: Acts 1:8)

OBSERVE - In your own words, what did you just read? (example: The Holy Spirit gives power to people to witness about Jesus.)

APPLY - Is there anything you can learn from this? (example: The Holy Spirit can help me tell my friends about Jesus.)

DO - Is there anything today's reading causes you to want to do or change? Write a short prayer asking God to help you do this. (example: God, please help me to be able to have the courage to talk to my friends about you and tell them how much you love them. Amen)

A NOTE FOR PARENTS:

Help your kids experience the power of God's Word in their lives as you have, with the kids Bible reading plan. Below is an easy way for your family to experience the Bible together! Here is how it works:

1. You keep doing the adult ROAD plan that we started at the beginning of the year.
2. Use this shortened guide for your children who may be too young to tackle a whole chapter each day.
3. Your child will be reading a portion of the same passage you are reading each day. So make sure to spend time talking about it with your child. Even if they are old enough to read it independently, they may need you to fill in some context for them to help make sense of what they are reading.
4. Feel free to adapt this to meet the needs of your child.
 - Read with your child or let them read it independently
 - Have them write in a journal or write it for them or just discuss it
