What to Expect Monday

The very first thing to do upon arrival is drop off your luggage with our luggage trailers. Then you will go to the lobby for check in.

During check-in:

- We check in ALL medications and put them into a ziplock baggie w/your name on it.
(Please make sure ALL medications are listed on the 2026 Student Release & Waiver form.)

Cell Phone Policy

Cell phones will be allowed at camp with limited use. We want our students to have the opportunity to take pictures at camp and post about what's going on at camp.

However—

1. Phones will not be allowed out during any teaching time, worship time, or bed time. If a student is found with their phone during any of the previously stated times, **any of our adult volunteers have the authority to take their phone for the day** (caught at night will be for the next day).
2. **If a student is caught doing anything inappropriate with their phone (pictures or communication), that student will be sent home with a parent.**
3. Phones will be collected every night by their family group leaders and put in a safe location. Phones will be redistributed every morning by their family group leader.
4. If your student calls you about going home call Brian, Alyssa, or Olivia before coming to Falls Creek. Our goal is to keep them at camp but we won't hold your kid hostage if they no longer want to be there.
5. If you feel that your student is unable to abide by our new cell phone policy, please don't send them to camp with a cell phone.

DRESS CODE

All apparel judgements will be left to the discretion of the Falls Creek Staff (FCS). If FCS determines a camper or campers should change their clothing to fall in line with camp requirements, then said camper or campers are required to do so.



ALWAYS ACCEPTABLE SHIRTS

Shorts must extend to or just beyond the campers' finger tips.

Sleeveless shirts must extend all the way to the shoulder seam.

Dresses/Skirts must reach the top of the knee.

Shoes must be worn at all times outside of your cabin.

T-shirts and cover-ups must be worn to and from swimming venues.

SWIMWEAR

male female
Should wear swimsuits of modest length (finger tips) and not tight fitting. Modest one-piece.

male female
No short shorts or tight-fitting shorts. No two-piece.

Camper may not be barefoot on the way to and from venues.

Tights may be worn under a garment that meets the dress code. Tights/sliders do not extend the length of garments worn over them (shorts/skirts/dresses). **Tights are not pants.** No tight fitting or revealing clothing. This includes leggings or similar attire, which cannot be worn as pants.

WHAT NOT TO WEAR

No tank tops or shirts cut down the sides.

Undergarments must always be covered by outer garments (i.e. no boxer shorts hanging out or bra straps showing).

No Midriffs/racer backs. No sport bras as tops (includes the 5K).

No spaghetti strap tank tops/dresses.

Apparel may not display tobacco, alcohol, controlled substances, or inappropriate language or pictures.

Falls Creek Dress Code

(DRESSES, SHORTS, AND LEGGINGS)

All dresses must include accessory wear under or over any straps (spaghetti that do not cover the shoulder) and must be at the knee. All shorts and dresses should be modest length. At Falls Creek, modest shorts are defined as shorts dresses and skirts that must extend to, or just beyond, the campers' finger tips. Slits in dresses and skirts should also be modest in length. All apparel must cover the shoulder. **Leggings, jeggings, and yoga pants** fall under the category of "tight fitting" clothes and are NOT allowed unless worn under pants, shorts, or dresses of appropriate length.

(SHIRTS AND SHOES)

Tank tops are NOT allowed at Falls Creek. Sleeveless shirts are acceptable, but must go from the neck to the shoulder seam and not be split down the side. Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times outside cabins, except while swimming.

(SWIMMING)

Girls should wear modest one-piece swim suits. Males should not wear tight fitting swimming suits. **While going to and from the swimming areas, all campers** must wear shoes; males must wear a t-shirt and females must wear a long covering over their swimming suits.

PDA

Believing that modesty extends beyond the dress code, Falls Creek asks that students refrain from PDA (Public Displays of Affection). **Our sponsors will be diligent to communicate this guideline to our students.**

Pastor Brian and Rick sign a paper for Falls Creek stating we will abide by the dress code.

This is a non-negotiable

What to Bring

Bible, pen/pencil; toiletries: soap, shampoo, deodorant, toothpaste/toothbrush; towels, clothes for 5 days and 5 nights, wash cloth; bedding-sheets, or a sleeping bag, pillow; sunscreen. **Bring medications in original containers.**

Optional: softball glove/bat/ball, tennis shoes for recreation, swimsuit (see dress code), skateboards(must check boards in at falls creek), fishing poles.

What Not to Bring

No Laser pointers, weapons, tobacco products, vape devices, alcohol or controlled substances of any kind.

Spending Money

Students don't have to bring money, but most bring \$25-\$75. Snacks and drinks will be sold during the week, and the gift shop will have T-shirts, books, and other items. All purchases are optional.

IMPORTANT We'll take up a missions offering, and students are encouraged to give 10% of their spending money during the offering.
